Objectives Give Purpose

Objectives are what a student **must achieve to accomplish** what the teacher states are **to be learned, comprehended, or mastered.**

It is difficult if not impossible for a student to get the work done when the assignment does not spell out what the student is to learn.

Why do Students Get Low Grades

1. They do not know what to do (Procedures)
2. They do not know what they are to learn (Objectives)

Objectives Serve Two Purposes

1. The lesson objectives tell the **students what is to be accomplished.**
2. The lesson objectives tell the **teacher what is to be taught.**

Objectives are classroom learning targets.

When both the students and the teachers are moving towards the same goal, there is a greater chance for learning to take place.



Students know what they are aiming for, thus, they know what they are responsible for learning.
